

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

WALKER COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 3

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, as amended, that the Board of Commissioners (the "Board") of Walker County Emergency Services District No. 3 (the "District") will conduct its regular meeting, open to the public, at **6:30 p.m., Friday, October 13, 2023**, at the **Crabbs Prairie Volunteer Fire Department ("CPVFD"), 28 FM 1696, Huntsville, Texas 77320**, a location inside the boundaries of the District, at which meeting the following matters will be considered and acted upon:

1. Call meeting to order;
2. Roll call;
3. Public comment;
4. Approve minutes of the September 8, 2023 regular and September 22, 2023 special meetings;
5. Bookkeeper's Report, including:
 - a. authorize payment of bills/invoices; and
 - b. review investment report and authorize investment of District funds, as necessary;
6. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report;
7. Webmaster's Report;
8. CPVFD Fire Chief's Report, including:
 - a. fire operations;
 - b. status of build of new fire truck; and
 - c. status of procurement of District capital items through America Rescue Plan Act funding;
9. Discuss development of five (5) year strategic plan, including authorize obtaining proposals for same;
10. Discuss sales tax election process and take any necessary actions on same, including authorize obtaining proposals for sales tax consultant;
11. Discuss grant writing services for the District, authorize obtaining proposals and take any necessary actions on same;
12. Consider improvements to or to serve the District's real property and take any necessary actions on same;
13. Consider repair or maintenance items for the District's real property and take any necessary actions on same;
14. Authorize Commissioners attendance at SAFE-D Annual Conference;
15. Discuss and authorize letter of recommendation to Walker County Commissioner's Court in connection with Commissioner appointment(s);
16. Attorney's Report;
17. Executive Session pursuant to Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, (Open Meetings Act) to discuss matters, as may be necessary; and
18. Adjournment.

The Board of Commissioners is authorized by the Open Meetings Act to convene in closed or Executive Session for certain purposes. These purposes include: receiving legal advice from its attorney(s) pursuant to §551.071, Texas Government Code; discussing real property

matters pursuant to §551.072, Texas Government Code; discussing gifts and donations pursuant to §551.073, Texas Government Code; discussing personnel matters pursuant to §551.074, Texas Government Code; and, discussing security personnel or devices pursuant to §551.076, Texas Government Code. If the Board decides to enter into Executive Session regarding any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an Executive Session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and provision of the Open Meetings Act that authorizes the closed or Executive Session.
